Submission DEADLINE: January 10th, 2010 11:59 PM Eastern Time

### How it Works

STEP ONE: If you are an artist with Down syndrome, create a WSDS TShirt design ([www.worlddownsyndromeday.org](http://www.worlddownsyndromeday.org)) by hand or by computer using your choice of art. Create your design on an 8 ½ x 11 inch piece of bright white paper using a max of four colors. Your design must be your own original unpublished work and must not contain any third-party logos, trademarks or copyright materials.

STEP TWO: Mail your design (without folding it) to DSAGC-T-Shirt Design Contest, 644 Linn Street #1128, Cincinnati, OH 45203 dated by January 10th, 2010. Sorry, your submission will not be returned.

### Judging

FIRST ROUND: A panel of artists and marketing professionals will select the top 3 designs by merits of their Originality, Visibility, Completeness of Design and Feasibility

SECOND ROUND; The top 3 designs will be posted online at [www.dsaia.org](http://www.dsaia.org) for voting from January 21 to February 21. The design with the most votes by midnight February 21st wins!

### Your Reward

#### 1st PLACE WINNER:

- \$200 in cold hard cash presented to you at DSAIA's World Down Syndrome Day Festival on March 21
- Your design will be used on the official DSAIA World Down Syndrome Day T-Shirt which will be on sale at the DSAIA conference
- Your design may be worn across the country as affiliates are encouraged to download your design free of charge from the dsaia website and send it to their favorite t-shirt vendor in plenty of time for their own group's fundraising or awareness building event.
